



Criteria for AVID Graduation —12th Grade—



Membership in AVID is a privilege that requires successful completion of a yearly program in order to pass to the next grade level. Students who fail to meet the minimum requirements for each AVID grade level will be dropped from the program. Our goal is that when you graduate wearing the coveted AVID sash, it is symbolic of your success in AVID, in high school, and in preparation for entry into a four-year university.

NON-NEGOTIABLES—Failure to meet the following objectives will result in being dropped from AVID.

- **Pass AVID with a C or higher**
- **Maintain a respectful attitude and good behavior. This means a student has**
 - **no major referrals / suspensions**
 - **no major classroom disruptions**

AVID ESSENTIALS—Failure to complete the following requirements may lead to being dropped from AVID.

- **Attend school daily (no chronic absences)**
- **Maintain a 3.0 GPA**
- **Complete 12th grade A-G requirements**
 - **In the event of receiving a D or F in any class, you must attend credit retrieval or attend a community college to make up credits**
- **Complete a rigorous course of study**
 - **You must show commitment to take Honors and/or AP courses**
- **Complete 50 commitment hours (participated in a school sport, club, or volunteered for community service)**
- **Participate in AVID fundraisers**
- **Complete the SAT and the ACT Tests a 2nd time**
- **Apply to at least one 4-year university**
- **Complete the FAFSA**

Evaluation Process—

- **End of Qtr 1**—Reflect on progress in AVID and high school; receive feedback from AVID advisor. Students who cannot fulfill AVID requirements in the time left in the school year will be dropped from AVID.
- **End of Term 1**—Reflect again on progress; students who are in danger of failing to meet AVID objectives receive probation letters; students may be dropped
- **Progress Report Quarter 4**—Final evaluation: Students who have met requirements will graduate as an honored AVID grad; students who have not will receive no sash nor be invited to the AVID banquet.

Support Agreement:

I have read and understand the 12th grade AVID requirements for graduation as an AVID grad. I understand that failure to satisfy these requirements is cause to be dropped, to not receive an AVID sash, nor invitation to the AVID Senior Banquet.

- Take the SAT/ACT at least one time prior to the beginning of the senior year.

I understand that in order to give fair consideration to my involvement with the program, I must commit to remaining enrolled in the AVID elective for at least one year, and that I will be allowed to remain in the program only if I meet the student responsibilities outlined above.
